

# RISK ASSESSMENT – HARGRAVE PARISH COUNCIL

Notice Boards on Hargrave Green		<b>LOCATION:</b> Hargrave Village green
<b>OPERATIONS COVERED BY THIS ASSESSMENT</b> 3 Notice boards on Green beside each other. To determine the level of risk by accidental opening of access glass doors, plus general state of repair of notice boards to maintain safe structure.		
<b>MAX. NO. OF PEOPLE EXPOSED:</b> 30  <b>FREQUENCY &amp; DURATION OF EXPOSURE:</b> People walking past daily.		
<b>HAZARDS:</b> All 3 notice boards have fastenings for access to boards. These are in good condition. The notice boards are in a safe condition and secure. The surface coverings are variable and will need to be painted or varnished in the near future to ensure the boards remain sound.		
<b>ACTIONS ALREADY TAKEN TO REDUCE THE RISK:</b> No actions needed immediately but some programme to paint or re-varnish would be worth doing over the next year.
